#### What you need to do

Check the date, time and location (above)

You should be prepared to come to court on that date. If you are selected as a juror, you may be required to attend court for the duration of the trial.

Confirm on the day before you are due to attend

On the last working day before your summons, check that you are still required, by visiting juror.nsw.gov.au or calling 1300 780 199 after 4pm.

Trials can sometimes change at the last minute, so it's important to check. If the trial is scheduled for a Monday, you can check after 4pm on Friday.

For your convenience, you can request SMS confirmations and notifications. To set up SMS, visit:

Attend court

You may be selected to serve on a jury. Bring photo ID and banking details (so we can make any payments directly to your account) with you. You can also enter your banking details online.

#### What happens if you can't attend?

Jury service is a rewarding responsibility, and is a fundamental part of our justice system.

If you have good reason under the Jury Act NSW 1977, you can apply to be excused. You should do this as soon as possible. You can also request to be excused on the day, when you attend court.

If you do not attend, and have not been excused, you can be fined up to \$2,200.00.

The quickest way to apply to be excused is online:

Or you can fill in the form and return it. If you need more information, you can call (02) 6922 0970 between 8:30am and 4:30pm Monday to Friday.

#### What about my employer?

By law (Jury Act NSW 1977 and Fair Work Act 2009 Commonwealth) your employer must release you for jury service. Please advise your employer, as soon as possible, that you have received a jury summons.

Employers are liable to severe penalties if they dismiss a person from employment or disadvantage, alter or prejudice a person's position based on being summonsed to serve as a juror.

Your employer cannot force you to take holidays or sick leave to perform jury service.

#### **Accessibility**

If you require an accommodation such as hearing loop or wheelchair access in order to serve on a jury, please contact us on 1300 722 574 with your request, no later than 7 days prior to your summons date.
